- 20 girls and 12 boys
Register them for both the common entrance and the first school leaving.
- All 30 mothers were economically empowered with either start-up capital or money to upscale their existing business.
- This is what inspired us to launch the Operation Ten Thousand Francs child back-to-school project



Operation Ten thousand Francs a Child

- OPERATION TEN THOUSAND FRANCS A CHILD is a project that saw the day of light 12 years ago.
- The project was born after a need assessment in the Buea Municipality with the findings being developmental problems ranging from poverty to sanitary/health issues
- Amongst this wide range of societal ills, we were particularly struck by the number of street children and school dropouts who had the zeal to attend school but for one reason or the other could not afford the academic needs



Operation Ten Thousand Francs a Child (cont'd)

- Another category of kids we noticed were brilliant but underprivileged students who barely attend school under difficult conditions.
- In a bid to make these children happy, feel honored, and belong to the community, the idea of an educational project came to mind, to enable them to be comfortable by providing for their school needs.
